



Vacancy: Project Coordinator Summerschool (8 hours per week)

Clublokaal in Breda is looking for a project coordinator for the *Seasonal Work: Learning in Common* program. This is a temporary, paid position for 8 hours per week.

Starting: as soon as possible through January 2027.

About Clublokaal

Clublokaal is an artist initiative in the center of Breda, focused on community, sustainability, and social issues. Guided by solidarity and mutual support, Clublokaal explores forms of collective self-organization and shared management, both locally and beyond. Clublokaal is a place for artists, visitors, local organizations, and residents to create, present, and meet together. We organize exhibitions, workshops, open evenings, dinners, lectures, and other activities.

As a collective, Clublokaal adopts a non-hierarchical and collaborative approach. Our team is already diverse in age and background, and we would like to see it become even more diverse. We collaborate extensively with local (community) initiatives and believe it is important to appeal to a broad audience and encourage visitors to actively participate

Seasonal Work: Learning in Common

Seasonal Work explores how artists can collaborate with social initiatives and what they can learn from one another regarding the commons: shared forms of knowledge, resources, and care.

The program consists of:

- A **summer school** (August 21–26, 2026) for individual or collective creators, held on-site at Plaats De Kleine Aarde in Boxtel and at self-organized initiatives in Breda
- An **open work and presentation period** at Clublokaal (November 2026 – January 2027)

- 3 **Open Door weekends** with workshops and a public program at Clublokaal (November 2026 – January 2027)
- The **Winter Harvest festival and symposium** (January 2027)
- A publication in the form of an **Almanac**

For this project, we are seeking a project coordinator to help shape the program's content and practical organization.

Tasks

As a project coordinator, you will work closely with the Clublokaal team, fellow coordinators, and external partners. You will be (jointly) responsible for:

- Program Coordination
 - Developing the program and coordinating with speakers and partners*
 - for the summer school
 - for the open work period and Open Door weekends
 - for the Winter Harvest festival and symposium
- Supervision and Collaboration
 - Providing content-related and practical guidance to participants throughout the program, in collaboration with the Clublokaal team and external partners
 - Maintaining contact with participating social initiatives and partners
- Production and Organization
 - Planning and execution on-site*
 - of the summer school (daily programs, logistics, catering, transportation)
 - of the open work period and Open Door weekends
 - of the Winter Harvest festival and symposium

Profile

We are looking for someone who:

- Has an affinity for art, the commons, and collective practices
- Has experience with project coordination or production as a cultural worker
- Can work independently but also enjoys working in a collective setting
- Has strong organizational skills and can maintain an overview
- Has strong communication skills (preferably in Dutch and English)

- Is interested in themes such as the commons, ecology, and community art
- Is familiar with Breda, has a local network, and can be flexible with their schedule to be present on-site

Experience with educational programs, publications, and self-organization is a plus.

If you don't meet all these requirements but think this position is a good fit for you, we encourage you to apply.

What we offer

- A paid freelance assignment averaging one day per week, from August 2026 through January 2027
- Work within a small, dedicated team of artists and cultural professionals
- The opportunity to contribute to an experimental and educational program focused on art, the commons, and self-organization
- A network of artists, researchers, and social initiatives

The exact fee will be determined by mutual agreement, in accordance with standard rates in the cultural sector.
